1. For Recruiting Year 2025-26, the recruitment of Junior Commission Officer (Catering) will be carried out in following phases:-

- (a) Part I - Eligibility Criteria, Physical and Medical Standards.
- (b) Part II - Registration of candidates through Join Indian Army Portal.
- (c) Part III - Online Common Entrance Examination.
- (d) Part IV - Recruitment Rally (Physical Fitness Test/Physical Measurement Test/ Medical Examination).
- (e) Part V - Interview and Skill Test.
- (f) Part VI - Final Merit and Call up for Training.
- (g) Part VII - Important Instruction of Candidates.

PART I : ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA, PHYSICAL AND MEDICAL STANDARDS


Eligibility Criteria


2. **Age Limit.** 21-27 Years (as on 01 October 2025). Candidate born between 01 October 1998 to 01 October 2004 (both days inclusive) are eligible to apply.

Note. Candidates to produce Birth Certificate/10th class marksheet at the time of preliminary document check at the time of Recruitment Rally.

3. **Educational Qualification.** The selection of candidates will be carried out for Junior Commission Officer (Catering) as per qualitative requirement:-

(a)	The candidate must be in possession of the following qualifications :- (i) 10+2 or equivalent from any Education Board recognised by Council of Board of School Education in India. Candidates should have working knowledge of either English or Hindi or both.

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	<p>(ii) Diploma/ Certificate Course of a duration of one year or more in Cookery/Hotel Management and Catering Technology from a recognised University/Food Craft Institute. Course recognized by the following Govt Agencies will be considered for eligibility for recruitment of JCO (Catering):-</p> <p>(aa) Catering courses run by institutes which are recognised by universities under the aegis of Association of Indian Universities.</p> <p>(ab) Catering courses run by the institutes which are recognised by Central AICTE or the AICTE, Regional Offices.</p> <p>(ac) Institutes of Hotel Management (IHMs) / Food Craft Institutes (FCIs) under control of Human Resources Development.</p> <p>(ad) Hotel Management / Catering courses from Institutions which have been recognised by the respective States.</p>
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Note:- The above mandatory educational qualification should be acquired by individuals from recognised universities.

5. **Medical Standards.** A candidate should have robust physique and mental health, chest should be well developed having minimum 5 cm expansion, should have normal hearing with each ear. He should have sufficient number of natural teeth, i.e. 14 dental points with healthy gums. Candidate should not have diseases like deformity of bones, hydrocele, varicose veins or piles.

PART II: REGISTRATION OF CANDIDATES THROUGH JOIN INDIAN ARMY PORTAL

6. **Procedure for Online Registration.**

- (a) Online Registration (submission of application) will be through Join Indian Army Portal only.
- (b) All candidates to log in to joinindianarmy.nic.in, check their eligibility status and create their profile.
- (c) Candidates should apply only once in response to this Notification.
- (d) Candidates are required to have an active email & mobile number which will be used for further communication.

- (e) Candidates are advised to upload only recent photographs on Join Indian Army (JIA) website. In case of uploaded photographs not matching with face, candidate will not be allowed to appear in the online Common Entrance Examination (CEE).
- (f) Candidates must indicate five choices of the exam centre. All possible effort would be taken to allot exam centre based on these choices.
- (g) Indian Army reserves the right to allot exam centre other than the five choices depending on the number of candidates. In that case, candidates may be asked to appear at any place of exam centre other than that specified by them.
- (h) Request for change of exam centre or date of selection test will not be entertained.
- (j) **Examination Fee.** Examination fee of **Rs 250/-** is to be paid by the candidate for the online examination. The candidate, on successfully filling the application will be directed to a payment gateway portal through a link on the website for the fee payment. The payment can be made through any of these payment options available :-
- (i) Payment Gateway Facility through Maestro, Master Card, Amex, VISA, Rupay Cards both Credit & Debit of all major banks.
 - (ii) Internet banking.
 - (iii) UPI.
- (k) Duplicate/Incomplete/Erroneously filled application will be rejected.
- (l) Candidates will be issued with Admit Cards for appearing in the Online Common Entrance Examination (CEE) subsequently through the Join Indian Army (JIA) portal. Candidates can download Admit Card after clicking the link on Join Indian Army website. Candidate has to put his User Name (which is the Roll Number of candidate) and Password as received by SMS/Email.
- (m) Candidates not reporting for the test on due date & time will not be accommodated on other dates.

PART III : ONLINE COMMON ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (CEE)

7. Candidates will have to appear for the Online CEE at the allotted Computer Based Test Centres spread pan India
- (a) Candidates should download their Admit Card & carry a colour printout for entry at the examination centre. All instructions given on Admit Card must be read by the candidates carefully and they should adhere to the instructions.
 - (b) Entry gates at examination center will be opened one and a half hour prior to scheduled time of exams and will close 30 mins prior to time of exam. No candidate will be allowed to enter once the entrance gate is closed.
 - (c) No electronic gadgets are permitted at the examination centres. Candidates will undergo following activities at the exam centre :-

- (i) Frisking at Entry Gate.

- (ii) Checking of Admit Card & Aadhar Card at the checking point.
- (iii) Auto allotment of Examination Hall.
- (iv) Attendance at Examination Hall gate.
- (v) Capture of biometric data before entering the examination hall.
- (vi) Login ID to allotted computer terminal.
- (vii) Appear for test as per procedure.
- (viii) Exit Biometric before exiting the Examination Hall.

(d) Online test will be mouse click based, objective Multiple Choice Question (MCQ). As per category of application the candidates would be required to answer the questions in allotted time.

(e) Marking pattern for online test:-

- (i) Full marks for every correct answer.
- (ii) Nil marks for unattempted question.
- (iii) All questions, if attempted, will be considered for evaluation, even if marked for review.

(f) Marks scored by the candidates in Online Common Entrance Examination (CEE) will be Normalised (if exam is held in more than one session) to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question paper across different sessions.

(g) In case any candidate is found using unfair means, the candidate will not be allowed to complete the exam and the candidature of the candidate will be cancelled.

8. **Junior Commission Officer (Catering) {JCO (Catering)}**. The online examination will contain objective type of questions and comprise of one paper as follows:-

9. **Minimum Passing.** It will be mandatory that candidate obtain a min 40% marks in written paper. Successful candidates will be shortlisted for appearing in the PFT/PMT/MEDICAL Examination proportionate to the vacancies available.

Note:- Merely passing in the Online exam does not guarantee the candidate to be called for appearing in the Recruitment Rally (PFT/PMT/Medical Examination).

PART IV : RECRUITMENT RALLY (PFT/ PMT/ MEDICAL EXAMINATION)

10. The Roll Number of the candidates who are in merit and are shortlisted will be published in the Join Indian Army website for appearing in the recruitment rally. These candidates will receive a second Admit Card for rest of the recruitment process as per Rally Schedule of Army Recruiting Office (AROs). The Admit Card for Phase II of recruitment process can be downloaded online under candidate's login (profile) on Join Indian Army web portal www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. Shortlisted candidates will have to report on the stipulated date and time for phase II at the designated Recruitment Rally venue with following document /certificate in original alongwith two self attested photocopies with them:-

- (a) **Admit Card**. Printed on good quality paper (do not shrink the size).
- (b) **Photograph**. Twenty (20) copies of unattested Passport size colour photographs developed on good quality photographic paper in white background not more than three months old. Computerised/ photocopied/photo shopped photographs will **NOT be accepted. Photographs must be with proper haircut and clean shave (except Sikh Candidates)**.
- (c) **Education Certificates**.
- (i) Education Certificate with marks sheet of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e Matric/Intermediate etc from recognised School/ College/Board/University.
- (ii) Provisional/online education certificate should be certified in ink signed by the head of the educational institution of concerned Board/University.
- (iii) Candidates with matric certificate from Open School should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by BEO/DEO.
- (d) **Domicile Certificate**. Domicile Certificate with photograph issued by Tehsildar/ District Magistrate.
- (e) **Caste Certificate**. Caste Certificate affixed with photograph of the candidate issued by the Tehsildar/District Magistrate.
- (f) **College Character Certificate**. Character Certificate issued by the College Principal where the candidates last studied.
- (g) **Character Certificate**. Character Certificate with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/Municipal Corporation within last six months from the date of despatch.
- (h) **Relationship Certificate**. Son of Servicemen (SOS)/Son of Ex-servicemen (SOEX)/Son of Widow (SOW)/Son of War Widow (SOWW) Candidates are required to produce the following documents :-
- (i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Record Office only duly signed by Record Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particular of the Record Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal/stamp is endorsed. Relationship certificate should bear water marks of the concerned Records.
- (ii) A declaration to the effect as mentioned in Affidavit on Ten Rupees Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the ESM duly signed by 1st Class/Executive/Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. **Format of Affidavit is attached as per Appendix 'A'**.
- (iii) Original Discharge Book of Ex-Servicemen also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.
- (j) **Affidavit**. Duly signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-Judicial Stamp Paper as per specimen duly attested by Notary will be submitted by candidate at the Rally Site without fail. **Format of Affidavit attached as per Appendix 'B'. Submission of Affidavit is Mandatory to gain entry into the Rally. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the rally without Affidavit.**

(k) **PAN Card & AADHAR Card.** PAN Card & Aadhar Card are mandatory documents for final enrolment for purpose of Pay & allowances and other social benefits scheme.

(l) Police Character Certificate.

(m) Sarpanch/Nagar Sewak (Residence Proof).

11. **Physical Fitness Tests (PFT).** As part of screening process the candidate will be subjected to PFT. Candidates are required to qualify in all physical fitness tests. Marks obtained in PFT will not be considered while finalizing the final merit. The following tests will be conducted in accordance with the laid down standards in vogue :-

12. **Adaptability Test.** All candidates who qualify the Physical Fitness Test (PFT) & Physical Measurement Test (PMT) will have to undertake Adaptability Test as per policy in vogue. Adaptability Test is for selection of candidates who can adapt to the environment of the Indian Army and are able to adapt to the challenges of military life. Those candidates who qualify the Adaptability Test will be eligible for Medical Test & further recruitment process. Those candidates who do not qualify the Adaptability Test will not be allowed for further participation in recruitment process.

13. **Medical Examination.** Candidates who qualify in the Physical fitness test and PMT will be subjected to detailed Medical examination by respective Recruiting Medical Officer/Medical Specialist.

Note : Candidates discharged from the Indian Armed Forces for any reason are not eligible to appear in the selection test.

PART V : INTERVIEW AND SKILL TEST

14. **Interview/Skill Test.**

(a) Candidates scoring min 40% marks in written Paper will be counted for preparation of merit list for appearing in the interview or final selection.

(b) The names of candidates declared successful in the written examination, PFT/PMT/Medical and short listed for interview will be published on the website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in by HQ Recruiting Zone, Bangalore.

(c) Candidates who have been shortlisted will be subjected to Skill Test/ Interview by board of officers at 2 ASC Centre (South), Bangalore. Candidates need to score minimum 50% mks in Skill Test/ Interview to qualify for consideration in the final merit.

(d) The final selection will be based on merit list drawn on the basis of the total marks obtained in written and interview.

- (e) **No bonus marks** is entitled to son of Serving/Ex-servicemen/War Widow/Widow /Sportsmen/NCC and Computer course certificate holders.

PART VI : FINAL MERIT AND CALL UP FOR TRAINING

15. The final merit shall be prep on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the written examination and Skill Test/ Interview (Relative weightage to the written test and interview/skill test will be in the proportion of 80% and 20% respectively).
16. Successful candidates will be intimated through e-mail/callup letters for further training in the Regimental Centre.

PART VII : OTHER IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

Terms & Conditions for Recruitment.

17. Candidates finally selected will be enrolled as provisional (Catering) JCO and will undergo Six weeks of Basic Training at ASC Centre (South), Bangalore. On successful completion of training the candidates will be commissioned as JCO Catering in the rank of Naib Subedar as per existing terms and conditions. Rejection can take place at any stage during training also.
18. All the above terms and conditions, vacancies and selection procedures are subject to change from time to time. **Only male candidates** are eligible to apply.

19. Important Instructions to Candidates.

- (a) Details about required educational qualification, physical/medical standards and job specification are available on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in under the candidate's login and this information can be accessed by the candidate without signing in.
- (b) Animated videos "How to Register & Apply" and "How to Appear for Online Common Entrance Examination" (CEE) are available on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in.
- (c) Category wise link has been provided on Join Indian Army (JIA) website to enable candidates to practice online Common Entrance Examination as per their category. All candidates are advised to carry out practice at least once before appearing for actual Common Entrance Examination (CEE).
- (d) Candidates are to reach at the examination Centre with colour print out of Admit Card. Candidates shall be debarred from appearing in online test in case anomalies/irregularities/ incorrect information are observed during initial verification at the examination venue or at any subsequent stage of selection process.
- (e) The candidates should carry their AADHAR Card (as displayed on the Admit Card) as proof of identity whenever they report for the Selection Test (Phase-I, II & III) and Medical Test.
- (f) **Help Desk for Registration.** A helpdesk will be effective for answering all the queries pertaining to registration process. The candidates may approach helpdesk number **011-25686451** which will function from **0900 hours to 1330 hours – 1400 hours to 1700h from Monday to Friday(except on National Holiday)**. In case of query on online application, mail can be sent on e-mail Id wm.joinindianarmy@gov.in.

20. **Additional Instructions.**

- (a) List of recognised universities is as given on the official website of UGC.
- (b) **01 October 2025** will be taken as effective date of determining age eligibility for candidates.
- (c) Personnel e-mail ID and Mobile Number is **MUST**. All communication will be sent on this e-mail ID/ Mobile Number viz-a-viz short list/call letter/joining instruction/result etc. Sharing of e-mail ID and Mobile Number is not permitted. Remember the **User Name** and **Password** for future use. (AROs will not be responsible for candidates not getting required information if e-mail/ Mobile Number given is wrong/ changed). No communication will be carried out through postal services.
- (d) Candidate's Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name and DOB must be entered exactly as per Matriculation/10th Class Board Certificate.
- (e) Candidate must enter contact details and permanent home address exactly as per Domicile/Nativity/Permanent Residential Certificate issued by Sub Divisional Magistrate/ District Magistrate.
- (f) Candidates who are serving with any government organization and are selected for the interview will produce "**No Objection Certificate**" from their employer at Zonal Recruiting Office before dispatch.
- (g) **Any candidate who has not received Admit Card 05 days prior to the Rally, may approach Army Recruiting Office (ARO) responsible for his district for further clarification.**
- (h) **Candidates will be permitted entry into the rally site only on production of Admit Card in duplicate generated online through the official website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. Anyone found with fake Admit Card will be handed over to Civil Police.**
- (j) Candidates are required to report at the Rally Site by the specified time given by ARO who is organizing rally on their respective scheduled dates. Candidates reporting after the specified time and without appropriate justification will not be permitted to participate in the Rally. **Candidate should be clean shaven** (except Sikh Candidate).
- (k) Candidate must carry their **AADHAR** Card as proof of identity which will be authenticated biometrically at the Rally Site. Candidates to ensure **AADHAR** details are matching with the details mentioned in the documents and Online Application.
- (l) Those not in possession of required documents will not be permitted to participate in the Rally.
- (m) Certificates with overwriting, tampering of seals or erasing/ alteration of any type will be rejected.
- (n) Character certificate produced by the candidate without photo attested by certificate issuing authority will be rejected.
- (o) Mobile phones are not permitted in the rally site.

- (p) At the rally site, all candidate should report duly shaved (beard, chest hair, axillary hair, pubic hair and with crew hair cut (except Sikh Candidates), for identification at various stages of rally process failing which candidate can be barred from participation in recruitment rally.
- (q) Candidates may have to present themselves at rally site for two to three times as required. Candidates should make arrangements for stay under their own arrangements.
- (r) **Candidates to come for the rally only on the date as mentioned in the Admit Card.** Candidates should bring pen, handkerchief.
- (s) **Tattoo.**
- (i) Candidates belonging to tribal communities/from tribal areas, are permitted to have permanent body tattoos on any part of the body, as per existing customs and traditions of the said tribe to which a candidate belongs. Such candidates will only be permitted on producing the following two certificates: -
- (aa) Self certification certificate to be signed by the candidates is attached as **Appendix 'C'**.
- (ab) Certificate of belonging to a tribal community and permissibility of permanent Body Tattoo(s) to be signed by DC/DM or SDM of the District/Tehsil where the tribe of the candidates is presently settled is attached as **Appendix 'D'** (Name and designation of the concerned official must be clearly mentioned).
- (ii) Permanent body tattoos of religious sentiment are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection.
- (t) **Use of Performance Enhancing Drugs. Use of any kind of performance enhancing drugs is strictly banned. Any candidate found in possession of or have used the same will be debarred from further screening.**
- (u) Selection is provisional till they report to the allotted Regimental /Corps Training Centre for training and their enrolment form is filled.
- (v) Candidates are advised in their own interest to undergo medical exam before coming for selection especially with respect to flat foot, poor vision, deformities and physical measurements. All are advised to ensure that their ears are free of wax by getting it cleaned by a doctor prior to the rally.
- (w) If there is a lapse of 270 days or more between screening medical at the rally and despatch, medical will be done again and unfit candidates in this review will not be recruited.
- (x) No use of contact lenses.

(y) **Final Result will be declared on the official website joinindianarmy.nic.in.** No separate letter will be sent to the candidate. It is responsibility of candidate to check his result and report to Army Recruiting Office (ARO) for further formalities.

(z) **Touts.** In the past, a number of candidates have been found victims of touts, fake documents/impersonation and in the bargain have lost their candidature. Modus operandi/means used by the touts are as under: -

(i) **Issue of fake PFT Slips/impersonation during various stages of rally. Conduct fake recruitment rallies.**

(ii) **Snatching/taking away original certificates from candidates who have been declared fit at initial stage and thereafter harassing them.**

(iii) **Taking away "ADMIT CARD" from the candidates under plea that they will follow up their results.**

(iv) **Giving candidates false assurance of "RECRUITMENT" as they claim to have links at appropriate level, thereby winning confidence of candidates.**

(v) **Once a candidate gets through on his own efforts, touts demand money in return of the original certificates.**

(aa) Recruitment into the Army is fair and transparent. Candidates are advised not to pay bribe to anyone for recruitment as it is based purely on merit. Selection process during recruitment at all stages is automated. Therefore, candidates are advised to be beware of touts as they cannot help them at any stage.

(ab) Giving/taking bribe, production of bogus/fake certificates and indulging in unfair means is a criminal offence and liable for punishment under law. Such candidates will be immediately handed over to Civil Police and their candidature cancelled.

(ac) **All documents submitted by the candidates are verified by government agencies before enrolment into Army. Legal action will be taken against individuals submitting fake documents. Even after recruitment, the service will be terminated, if candidates are found to have produced fake documents or have given wrong information at the time of recruitment, despite the number of years of service the individual may have rendered.**

(ad) No compensation for Death/Injury/loss etc during the rally and no travelling allowance/dearness allowance for journey is admissible. Candidates will participate in the rally at their own risk and the participation is totally and entirely voluntary. The signing of Indemnity Bond is a mandatory requirement.

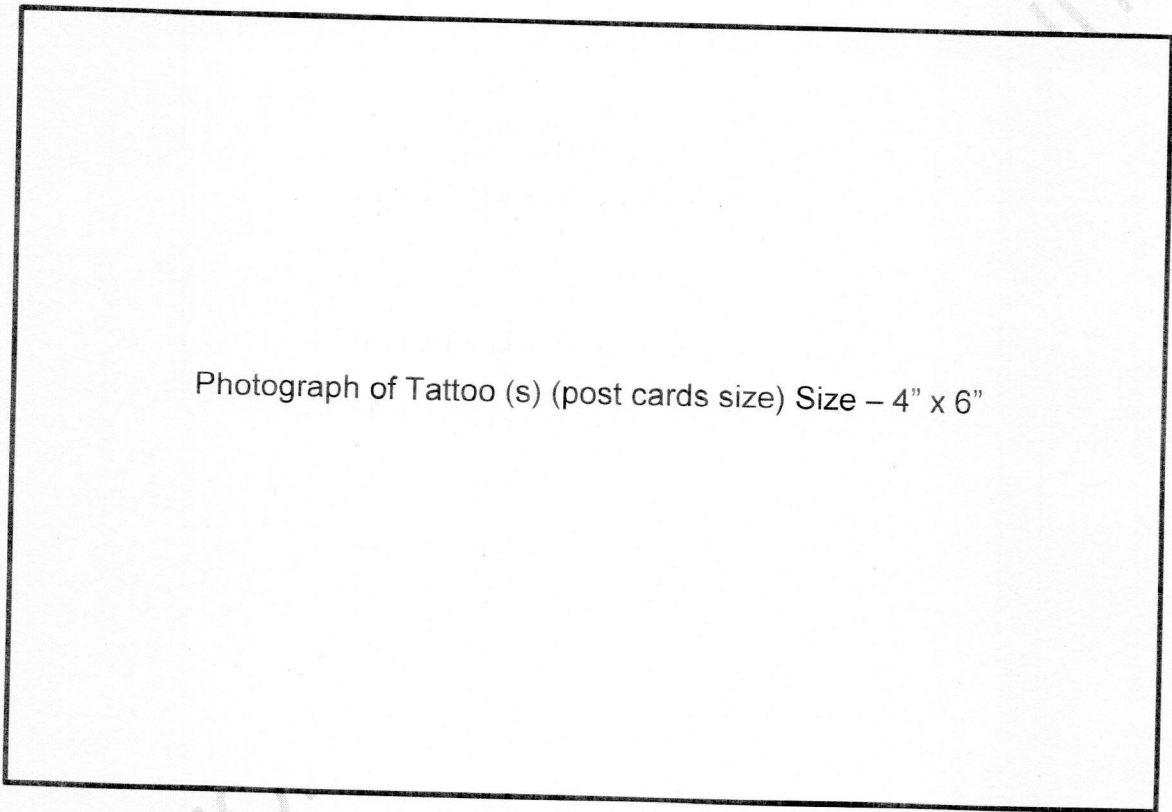
